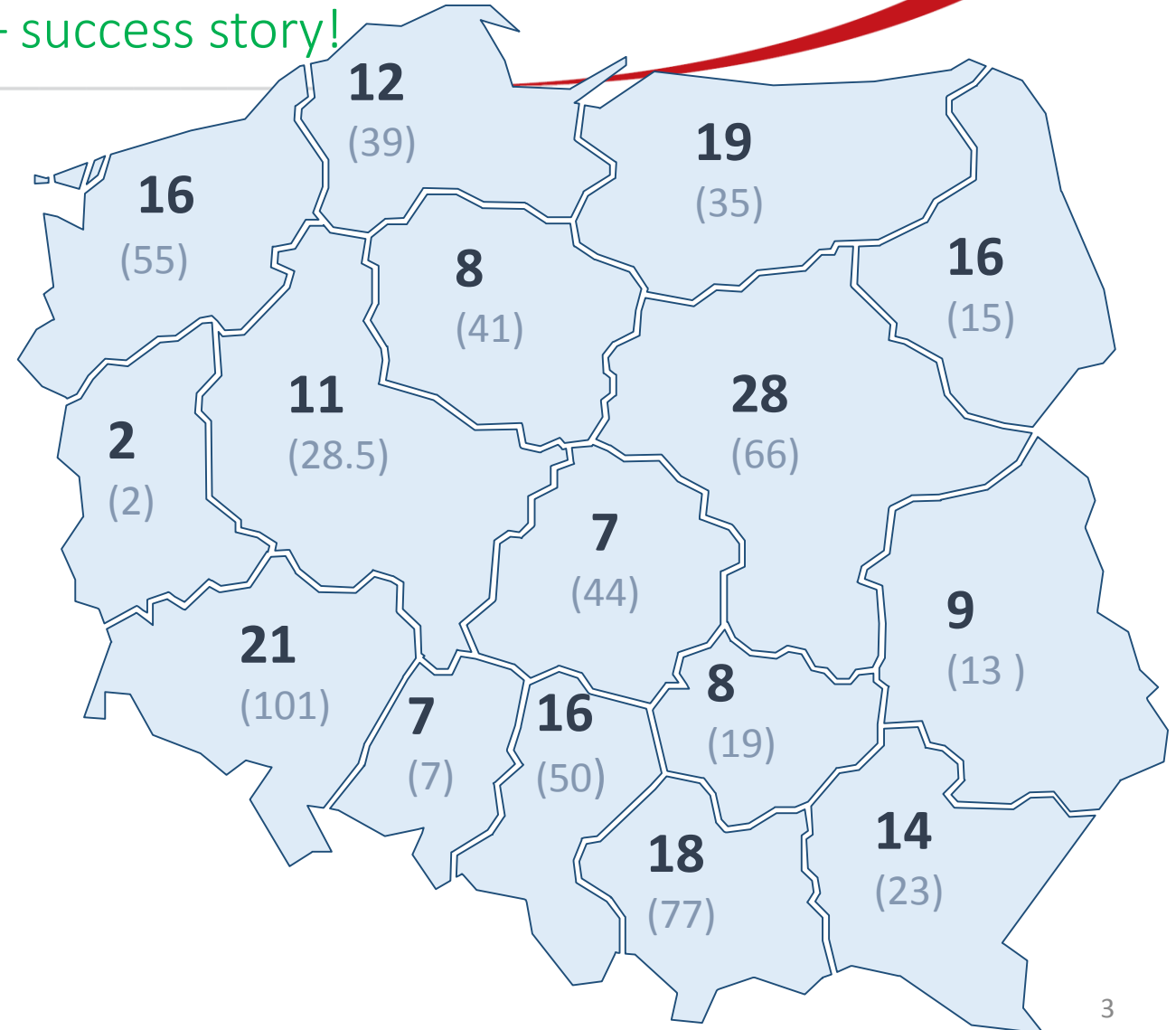
Not included above:

EEA and Norway Grants often seen as a beneficiary-friendly

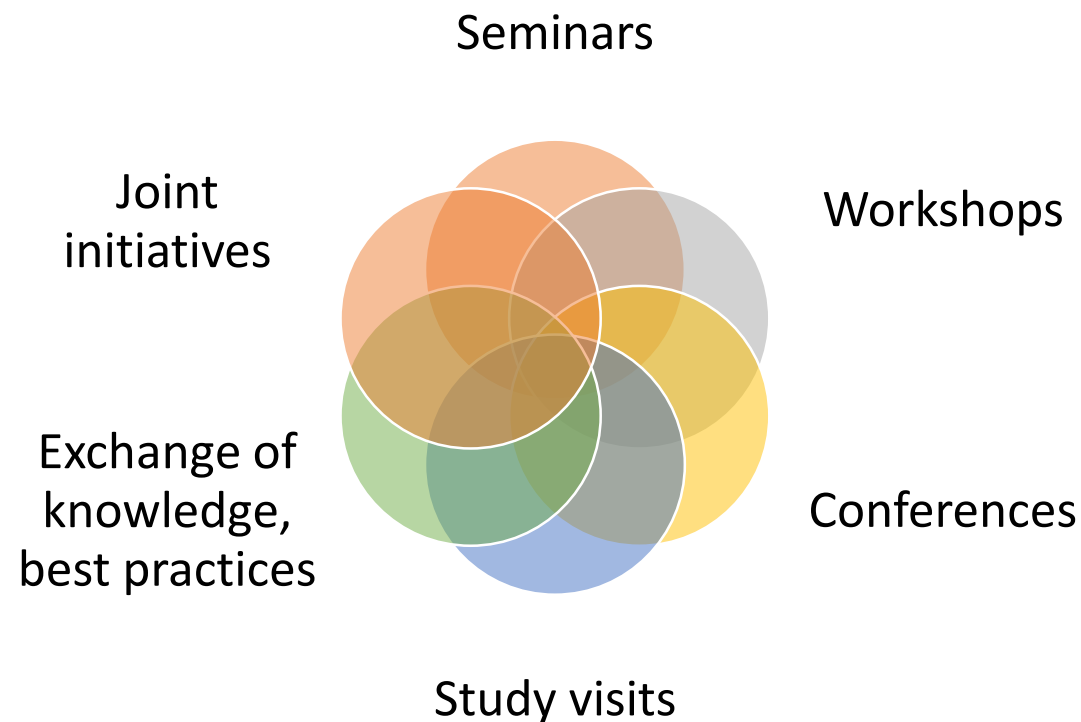
Results above the expectations

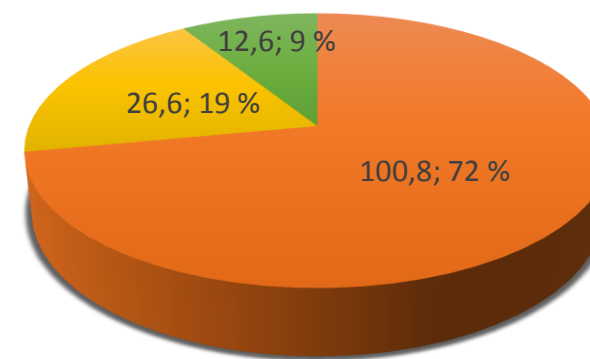
EEA and Norway Grants 2014-2021
