His main field of work are applied econometric studies of various microeconomic issues related to the labor market, business economics, energy and environmental economics. He has participated in several economic studies in the transport sector such as evaluation of the Gardermoen project and high-speed trains in Norway. In the past, he has been working on estimates of tax burdens and is now in dialandue with the Ministry of Finance about the preparation of new estimates. He participated in the start-up of the Concept prandramme and participated in the design of quality assurance schemes. He has been a quality assurer in several of Vista's projects.
